

## 2019 Accomplishments

- 11,470 plugs planted
- 3,593 gallons of herbicide applied
- 3,843 lbs. native seed sowed
- 266 acres Rx burned
- 226 acres rough-cut mowed
- 63 individual volunteers
- 23 brush piles burned
- 15 volunteer workdays
- 9.86 acres cleared of invasives
- 5 seasonal employees
- 4 trees planted



- Matching grant for the reduction of nonpoint source pollution
- Administered by Lake County SMC
- Funding provided in part by the Illinois EPA through Section 319 of the Clean Water Act
- Focused on 42 acres of retired agricultural land north of Casey Rd.



#### Goals:

- Eliminate soil erosion
- Slow the movement of water through the site
- Reduce the amount of runoff
- Provide habitat for plants and animals
- Promote downstream water quality



#### • Plan:

- 18,658 SqYds erosion control blanket
- 5,141 LF drain tile removed
- 9,950 plugs installed
- 2,662 lbs. native seed sowed over -
- 42 acres
- 14 rock grade control structures
- 2 culverts

- Casey trail bisects unit
- Restoration bridges gap between north and south restoration areas
- Frontage clearing, Rx burn, herbicide application, seeding, plug planting and mowing

## Rt. 137 Clearing – A Continuation

- Further thinning of undergrowth, dead and diseased trees, and invasive species
- Increased light penetration through canopy to understory
- Promotes prairie/savanna vegetation establishment

- Didn't meet current needs no 4X4, low towing/hauling capacity, etc.


## Equipment Purchase



- Begin construction soon




#### Project Kick Off- St. Mary's Drainage






