Highway Commissioner's Report

Highway Commissioner Neal thanked the Supervisor for putting together the July 30th Special Call Meeting for the purchase of the truck.

The Rockland Road Project is near completion. On August 11, 2020, there was an Open House for the Oak Spring Road Bridge Improvements Study. Social distancing and masks were practiced. There were less than 10 people in attendance.

Trustee August thanked the Highway Commissioner for the great job the Road District is doing especially considering the amount of water we have had this year.

Supervisor's Report

In July, there were 360 households that used the food pantry.

Girl Scout Sheila Tucker installed the "Little Library" for her Gold Star Project outside the Township building and it looks beautiful.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FROM R. E. DECKER FOR BOUNDARY STAKES ON OPEN SPACE PROPERTIES AT PETERSON & BUTTERFIELD ROADS DISCUSSION & VOTE

Supervisor O'Connor explained over the years the Township has been working to survey all our properties. The Rt. 137 was selected as the next site as recently there have been several downed trees; the surveying assists in determining if the trees are located on our property.

A motion by Trustee August and a second by Trustee Kovatch to approve the Proposal from RE Decker for Boundary Stakes on Open Space Property at Peterson & Butterfield Roads in the amount of \$13,500. Trustee Nield asked if the surveying and stakes were necessary. Supervisor O'Connor explained it was an activity that the has been done for many years and they have been very helpful for identifying encroachments. Trustee August said they have saved the Township money in the long term. On roll call vote: Trustee White, aye, Trustee Nield, aye, Trustee August, aye, Trustee Kovatch, aye, Supervisor O'Connor, aye. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FROM HEZCORP CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR SEMI-ANNUAL ROOFING INSPECTIONS DISCUSSION & VOTE

Per the warranty, the Township is required to have the new roof inspected by an entity qualified to conduct the inspection. Without the inspections, the warranty is void. In the proposal, Hezcorp also included the inspection Parks Building roof twice a year. Supervisor O'Connor said. The Board can approve the proposal and limit the inspections to the 359 Merrill Court building. After some discussion by the Board, the decision will be tabled for the next meeting. Supervisor O'Connor said she will follow-up with Hezcorp Construction regarding the questions posed by the Board.

APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FROM APPLIED ECOLOGICAL SERVICES FOR RT 45 PARCEL – DISCUSSION & VOTE

Supervisor O'Connor said the Township has received concerns from residents in Bull Creek regarding stormwater run-off. A few residents have strongly expressed concern the Rt. 45 property has not been restored. As presented in the AES Proposal, a preliminary assessment was conducted in 1997; the proposal is an update to the original assessment. The information provided will help in seeking grant opportunities as restoration will be extremely costly.

A motion by Trustee White, and a second by Trustee Nield to approve the Proposal from Applied Ecological Services in the amount of \$15,800 to conduct a Natural Areas Assessment and Management Plan for our 72-acre site. Trustee Kovatch said the proposal is reasonable. On roll call vote: Trustee White, aye, Trustee Nield, aye, Trustee August, aye, Trustee Kovatch, aye, Supervisor O'Connor, aye. Motion carried.

ELECTED OFFICIALS SALARIES AND COMPENSATION DISCUSSION & VOTE:

Supervisor O'Connor reminded the Board the salaries for all elected positions for the next term will need to be determined by November 7, 2020. The Board will need to vote in the form of a Resolution by the October 22nd Meeting. The Board was given a variety of options to consider. Trustee Nield asked for information on health insurance costs for the Elected Officials. Supervisor O'Connor said she would provide the information for the Board to review.
